The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.0394 dated 30.10.2024 registered under Sections 109, 331(7), 115(2), 126(2), 121(1), 122, 303(2), 238 of BNS (Section 191(3), 190 of BNS added later on), at Police Station City Faridkot, District Faridkot.
