VIKRAM AGGARWAL, J (ORAL)

1. Sh. Gurpreet Singh Khaira, IAS, Director Urban Local Bodies,
is present through video conference.

2. He has apprised the Court that the speaking order does not give
the right details in as much that the amount mentioned as ₹1800 Crores is
actually ₹18 Crore which remains to be settled by the Municipal Council,
Gidderbaha. He submits that as regards the pensionary benefits, there are
sufficient funds and all Urban Local Bodies are paying the same. Wherever
any Urban Local Body finds it difficult to pay the retiral benefits, they
connect with the office of the Director and the requisite amount is released.

3. As regards the present case, it has been submitted that the entire
benefits stand paid.

4. That being so, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court. Rule stands discharged. The contempt petition is accordingly disposed off.

Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
