1. The petitioner has filed the present petition with a prayer to issue a writ in the nature of *certiorari* for quashing of the order dated 14.07.2014 passed by respondent No.3, whereby, the services of the petitioner were terminated in violation of the rules. A further prayer has been made to direct the respondents to reinstate the petitioner w.e.f. 14.07.2011 and to grant the arrears of regular salary w.e.f. 08.11.2011 alongwith interest till the date of retirement.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that at this stage, she shall be satisfied, in case the appropriate directions are issued to the official respondents to look into the representation dated 25.10.2024 (Annexure P-11) submitted by the petitioners, which highlights the issues raised in the present writ petition.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Swapan Shorey, DAG, Punjab, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents and has no serious objection to the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioners, at this stage.

5. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the record carefully.

6. At this stage, this Court feels it appropriate to direct the respondent No. 2 to examine the representation dated 25.10.2024 (Annexure P-11) submitted by the petitioner and to pass a speaking and well reasoned order within a period of 04 months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

7. Needless to observe that the respondent No. 2 shall hear both the sides before passing an order.

8. In case, the petitioners are found to entitled to get consequential benefits, the same shall be released forthwith.
