VIKAS BAHL, J. (ORAL)

1. Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 & 227 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the impugned order dated 25.05.2017 (Annexure P-5) as well as impugned order dated 04.05.2022 (Annexure P-7) passed by respondent No.2, vide which the petitioner has been directed to vacate dwelling house forthwith.

2. During the course of arguments, it has not been disputed by learned counsel for the petitioner as well as private respondents that the petitioner is not staying in the house in question and is staying in a house



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taken by her on rent in the same locality and thus, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that however, the disposal of the present writ petition should not be come in the way of the petitioner to pursue other cases including the appeal filed by her in the domestic violence case and to claim rent etc.

4. Keeping in view the above-said facts and circumstances, the present writ petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

5. It is made clear that the present order would not come in the way of the petitioner to pursue other legal remedies. It would be open to the petitioner as well as to the private respondents to raise all pleas in the said proceedings and the same would be considered by the Court/forum independently, in accordance with law.
