1. The petitioners have filed the present petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of direction to the official respondents for protection of life and personal liberty of the petitioners from the hands of respondents No.5 and 6 with a further direction to respondents No.1 to 4 not to take any action on the instance/complaint of respondents No.5 and 6.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners states that both the petitioners are major and have married against the wishes of respondents No.4 and 5. They apprehend danger from respondents No.4 and 5. Their marriage certificate evidencing their marriage is on record as Annexure P-3. The petitioners have submitted a representation dated 02.04.2025 (Annexure P-4) to respondent No.2.

3. Notice of motion to the official respondents only.

4. Mr. Kirpal Singh Thakur, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the State.

5. Without entering upon an exercise to evaluate the evidentiary value of the documents placed on the file, I dispose of the petition with a

direction to respondent no.2- the Deputy Commissioner of Police, Panchkula to decide the representation (Annexure P-4) of the petitioners and grant them protection, if any threat to their life and liberty is perceived.

6. It is clarified that this order shall not be taken to grant immunity to the petitioners from legal action for violation of law, if any, committed by them. This order would not be understood having expressed any opinion whatsoever by this Court on the validity of the marriage of the petitioners.
