1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of B.N.S.S with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to her in case FIR No.30, dated 28.02.2025, under Sections 115(2), 118(1), 333, 303(2), 324(2), 190, 191(3) of BNS, registered at Police Station Sultanpur Lodhi, District Kapurthala (Annexure P-1).
2. While granting the concession of interim anticipatory bail by this Court on 09.04.2025, this Court had noticed the following contentions raised by learned counsel for the petitioner:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the alleged occurrence had taken place in the present case at 10:00 AM on 17.02.2025 and the FIR was got registered on 28.02.2025, after a delay of 11 days. Even, the injuries suffered by the opposite side were simple in nature and the petitioner is ready to join the investigation in the present case.”

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has reiterated the submissions and further submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and her custodial interrogation may not be required.

4. On the other hand, learned State counsel also submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation.

5. In view of the above statement made by learned counsel for the parties, the interim order dated 09.04.2025 is made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to join the investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 482 (2) of B.N.S.S.

6. Pending application(s) stand(s) also disposed of.
