KULDEEP TIWARI, J.(ORAL)

1. Through the instant writ petition, cast under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, a challenge is thrown to the order dated 29.10.2013 (Annexure P-9), passed by the Chief Engineer, Ranjit Sagar Dam Project, Irrigation Works, Punjab, Shahpur Kandi Township, Teshil and District Pathankot (respondent No.4), whereby, the claim of the petitioner for appointment being oustee was rejected, on the ground, that the acquired land of the petitioner is far less than the criteria laid down under the Rehabilitation and Resettlement Policy dated 18.11.1993 (Annexure P-1).

2. During the pendency of the instant writ petition, the claim of the petitioner was re-considered by the authorities concerned, and he was offered the appointment as T-MATE (Class-IV), on 22.08.2022.

3. In view of the supervening events, no further cause of action survives in the instant writ petition, and the prayer made in the instant writ petition is rendered infructuous.
