1. In the present petition, the petitioner is praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to release the interest on the delayed pension and pensionary benefits. The petitioner has also prayed for direction to the respondent to count his qualifying service for grant of revised pensionary benefits with effect from the date of joining the Corporation instead of the date of contribution to the provident fund.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner, on instructions from the petitioner, submits that at this stage, he will be satisfied if a direction may be

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given to the respondent to decide legal notice dated 10.01.2024 (Annexure P-11), in a time bound manner.

3. Learned counsel for the respondent does not oppose the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

4. In view of the above and without commenting upon the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to the respondent to consider and decide legal notice dated 10.01.2024 (Annexure P-11), within a period of 04 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law. In case, the petitioner is found to be entitled to the relief as claimed in the legal notice, the same be released within a period of two months thereafter.
