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3. Mr. Rajesh Kapila, Advocate, has appeared on behalf of the respondents No.4 and 5, and files his Power of Attorney, which is taken on record. He submits that as per averments taken in para 11 of the petition, it is stated that both the petitioners are major, unmarried and this is the first marriage of both the petitioners but in fact petitioner No.2 is already married with one Pinky and he produces a marriage certificate issued by Full Gospel Churches of India registered with Societies Registration Act (XXI of 1860) Amendment Act 1957.

3. In the said marriage certificate it is mentioned that marriage between Pinky and Nyson took place in the last week of May, 2024. The said marriage certificate is taken on record. Registry is directed to tag the same at an appropriate place to make this a part of the present petition.

4. This Court has also perused the photographs appended with the petition, which also creates a big doubt that whether actually petitioner No.2 has performed marriage or not because no one else is present except the petitioners.

5. Faced with the situation, this Court finds that an attempt has been made through the instant petition to misled the Court by taking a false averment.

6. Accordingly the present petition is dismissed.
