Prayer in the present application filed by the respondent No.2-Insurance Company is for disposing of the appeal in view of judgment dated 13.10.2014 passed in FAO No. 4202 of 2002.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the applicant that the appellant-claimant had already challenged the Award dated 01.03.2002 passed by the learned Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Patiala in respect of the accident dated 07.10.1997 in MACT Case No.5-T of 22.11.1997 by way of previous FAO No. 4202 of 2002. It is submitted that the previous FAO No. 4202 of 2002 already stands allowed by this Court vide order dated 13.10.2024; whereby the compensation of Rs.3,60,150/- awarded by the Tribunal has been enhanced to Rs.8,22,150/-. Copy of the said judgment has been placed on record as Annexure-A1.

Heard.

Notice was issued in the above said application on 13.12.2024. However, none appeared on two occasions on behalf of non-applicant/appellant. Thereafter on 25.04.2025 an adjournment was sought on behalf of non-applicant/appellant.

Today again none has appeared on behalf of the non-applicant/appellant.

In view of above said facts and the application which is duly supported by affidavit of Shama Arora, Mittal, Deputy Manager, United Indian Insurance Company, the application is allowed.

Main Case
