The present petition has been filed under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 seeking anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.0407 dated 21.10.2024 under Sections 115/127(2)/190/191(3)/351(3) of BNS registered at Police Station Sector 27, District Sonipat, Haryana.

On 11.04.2025, the following order was passed:-

‘ The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the BNSS for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.0407 dated 21.10.2024 under Sections 115, 127(2), 190, 191(3) and 351(3) of BNS 2023 registered at Police Station Sector 27, Sonipat, District Sonipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia contends that no specific injury has been attributed to the petitioner. He further contends that even the complainant Deepak Kumar has sworn an affidavit about the petitioner being not involved in the incident in question. He contends that the petitioner does not suffer from any criminal antecedents and no recovery is to be effected from him. He further submits that the petitioner is ready and willing to join the investigation as and when required to do so.

Notice of motion.

Notice re: stay as well.

Ms. Dimple Jain, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and prays for some time for filing reply, if so advised.

Adjourned to 11.07.2025.

In the meantime, the petitioner is directed to join investigation as and when required by the Investigating Agency/Officer. In the event of the petitioner joining investigation, he shall be admitted to interim bail by the arresting/investigating officer on his furnishing adequate bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the arresting/investigating officer. The petitioner shall, however, be bound to abide by the conditions as specified under Section 482 of the BNSS, 2023.’

Learned State counsel has filed status report by way of an affidavit and the same is taken on record and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of the statement of learned State counsel, order dated 11.04.2025 is hereby made absolute. The petitioner shall abide by the terms and conditions envisaged under Section 482(2) of BNSS (earlier Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.).

The petition stands disposed of.
