1. In the present petition, the petitioner is praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to regularize the petitioner with effect from 01.09.1992 instead of 20.07.2011 and to grant him all consequential benefits with interest.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he has served a legal notice dated 25.12.2024 (Annexure P-10) upon the respondents, however, no decision has been taken thereupon. Learned counsel for the petitioner, on instructions from the petitioner, submits that at this stage, he will be satisfied if a direction is given to respondent No.3 to decide the legal notice dated 25.12.2024 (Annexure P-10) in a time bound manner.
