NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner has filed the instant revision petition challenging the judgment dated 30.04.2009 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Hisar, whereby respondents No.2 to 7 were acquitted from the charges under Sections 498-A and 304-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860.

2. On the last date of hearing i.e. 19.02.2025, the following order was passed :-

“Learned counsel for respondents No.2 to 7 submits that the instant petition is now abated in view of the provision of Sections 435(2) of BNSS, 2023 as the petitioner-complainant has died on 06.08.2020, during the pendency of the present revision petition.

Adjourned to 19.05.2025.”
