1. The petitioners are seeking to quash the FIR No. 60, dated 01.10.2019, under Sections 406, 498-A of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Women, District Bathinda and subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of the compromise.

2. None has appeared on behalf of the petitioners and respondent no.2 despite pass over. Same was the position on the previous four consecutive dates of hearing. In terms of the order dated 15.02.2023, the notice was directed to be issued to the learned counsel for the petitioners, as well as, learned counsel for respondent no.2 for 12.07.2023. On 12.07.2023, it was observed that the

learned counsel for the petitioners, as well as, respondent no.2 have been informed through email, but none of them had appeared despite pass over.

3. In these set of circumstances, the instant petition is dismissed for want of prosecution.
