The allegation raised in the petition is with regard to the alleged illegal mining activities being carried out by respondent No.8.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that multiple representations have been submitted to the authorities, yet no action has been taken to date. The attention of Court has been invited to Annexure P-16, which is a comprehensive representation filed by the petitioner, highlighting facts before the authorities.

Learned State counsel submits that petitioner's representation shall be dealt with, as per law.

In view of the facts placed before us, we deem it appropriate to dispose of this petition by directing the respondents to examine the petitioner's grievance and decide the representation regarding the alleged illegal mining by respondent No.8, by passing a speaking order, after granting opportunity of hearing to both the parties, within a period of two months.

Needless to state that this order shall not be treated to be expression of opinion on the merits of the case of either party, for as indicated above, the competent authority shall examine the concerns/grievances of the petitioner, strictly in accordance with law.

Petition stands disposed of.
