1. This is a Civil Revision Petition filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for setting aside the order dated 08.02.2022, vide which the application filed by the respondents-plaintiffs under Order 39 Rules 1 and 2 CPC has been partly allowed by the Additional District Judge, Sangrur.
