1. The petitioner through instant petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondent No.2 to allow him to rejoin the service as Steno Typist in the office of respondent No.3 as has been requested vide its letter dated 18.12.2024 (Annexure P-7).

2. On 22.04.2025, this Court passed the following order: -

“The petitioner worked with respondent No.3-Palwal Co-operative Sugar Mills Ltd. from 2020 to May’ 2024. He was engaged through HKRNL. Post is still lying vacant with respondent No.3 who is interested to engage petitioner.

Ms. Rajni Gupta, Addl. A.G., Haryana seeks short accommodation to find out whether name of petitioner is active on HKRNL portal or not.

Adjourned to 30.04.2025.”

3. Ms. Rajni Gupta, Additional Advocate General, Haryana submits that the petitioner is still registered with Haryana Kaushal Rozgar Nigam and his claim for engagement with Palwal Co-op. Sugar Mills



Limited-respondent No.2 would be considered in accordance with law and noticing letter received from the aforesaid mill.

4. In the wake of statement of learned State counsel, the present petition stands disposed of.
5. Let the needful be done within four weeks from today.
