This is a petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a direction to official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner by providing adequate protection to the petitioner and also directing the private respondents not to interfere in the personal life and liberty of the petitioner.

Today learned State Counsel submits that vide rapat No. 19 dated 10.04.2025, the petitioners have given statement to the extent that they have no threat apprehension and their family is not against their marriage, hence, they do not want any legal action against anyone.

In view of the above, counsel for the petitioner does not wish to press the instant petition, hence, prays for withdrawal of the same.

Prayer is accepted.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
