1. Prayer in the present petition, filed under Section 482 of the BNSS, 2023 (erstwhile Section 438 of the Cr.P.C.), is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in a case FIR No.02 dated 05.01.2025, registered under Sections 318(4) of the BNS, 2023 and Sections 66(c) & 66(d) of the IT Act, 2000, at Police Station Cyber Crime, Fazilka, District Fazilka.

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in terms of the order dated 14.02.2025, the petitioner could not surrender before the learned Trial Court due to the circumstances beyond his control and prays for one another opportunity to surrender before the learned trial Court and file an appropriate bail application. Resultantly, he prays for withdrawal of the present petition, with the liberty aforesaid.

3. Allowed to do so.

4. Dismissed as withdrawn, with liberty as prayed for. If the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court within a period of three days from today and files an appropriate application for bail, then the trial Court would decide the same expeditiously, in accordance with law.
