(1) Learned counsel for the petitioners restricts his prayer for issuance of a direction to respondent No.3 to dispose of the petition filed by the petitioners under Section 10-A of Punjab Village Common Lands (Regulation) Act, 1961 (for short 1961 Act) as applicable to Haryana within a time bound manner.

(2) Learned counsel appearing for the contesting respondents have no objection to the acceptance of the afore alternate prayer made on behalf of the petitioners.
