This petition has been preferred under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of *ad-interim* anticipatory bail in FIR No.39 dated 26.02.2025 under Sections 15, 29, 61, 85 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (for short 'NDPS Act'), registered at Police Station City Moga, District Moga.
