1. Present petition has been preferred under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.07 dated 07.02.2025 under Sections 117(2), 115(2), 3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, registered at Police Station Sangat, District Bathinda.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that FIR (*supra*) has been registered against the petitioner after a delay of six months and all the offences mentioned in the FIR are bailable in nature. He wishes to withdraw the present petition.

3. On the other hand, learned State counsel submits that present petition is not maintainable, as the offences, under which the FIR (*supra*) is registered, are bailable in nature. Even the application filed by the petitioner seeking anticipatory bail in the FIR (*supra*) has already been dismissed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Bathinda, vide order dated 04.04.2025 (Annexure P-2). He further submits that in case the petitioner appears before the Investigating Officer, he would act, in accordance with law.

4. Dismissed as withdrawn.

5. However, it is made clear that if the petitioner appears before the Investigation Officer, he would consider all the aforesaid facts and would act, in accordance with law.
