8. In view of the above, both the aforementioned writ petitions are disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

9. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner(s) to revive these petitions in case any grievance survives.

10. All the pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
