SUDEEPTI SHARMA J. (Oral)

1. The present contempt petition has been filed for non-compliance of order dated 16.01.2020 passed by this Court in CWP-28912-2019.
2. The relevant portion of order dated 16.01.2020 passed by this Court in CWP-28912-2019 is reproduced as under:-

“In view of the above, present petition is allowed and a direction is given to the respondents to fix the salary of petitioner in the regular pay scale w.e.f. 01.10.2003 with all consequential benefits. This exercise will be completed within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and compliance thereof, be sent to this Court. In case no order is passed within the aforesaid period, cost of Rs.25,000/- shall be imposed upon the respondents.”

3. On 29.09.2025, this Court directed Secretary, Government of Haryana,

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come present in the Court on the next date of hearing i.e 27.10.2025 along with compliance affidavit. Though, on 27.10.2025, no exemption application was filed but learned State counsel sought more time to get instructions and the matter was adjourned for today i.e 03.11.2025. Today, the matter was taken up before lunch and the learned State counsel apprised the Court that the order dated 16.01.2020 has been duly complied with. However, Secretary, Government of Haryana, PWD (B&R) Department Haryana Mini Civil Secretariat, Sector 17, Chandigarh was not present and therefore, the matter was kept after lunch. Mr. Anurag Aggarwal, IAS has appeared through VC at 3 P.M and told that compliance is made and the amount due to the petitioner is deposited in his account.

4. In view of the above, order dated 16.01.2020 passed by this Court in CWP-28912-2019 has already been complied with.
5. Accordingly, the contempt is purged. Rule is *discharged*.
6. Pending application (s) if any also stands disposed of.
