1. This revision petition is filed against the judgment dated 31.10.2011 passed by learned Sessions Judge, Hoshiarpur, upholding the judgment of conviction and order on quantum of sentence dated 16.04.2008 passed by Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Garhshankar, whereby the petitioner was convicted under Section 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act and sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment for two years and to pay fine of Rs. 5,000/- with default mechanism.
2. Despite, the case having been called twice, there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner today. Same was the position on the last three effective dates of hearing. It appears that neither the petitioner nor his counsel is interested in pursuing the present petition.
3. Under these circumstances, having left with no other option, the present petition stands dismissed for want of prosecution accordingly.
