1. Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ, order or direction in the nature of certiorari for quashing the order dated 19.04.2022 (Annexure P-4) dismissing the application filed by the petitioner under the provisions of Maintenance & Welfare of Parents and Senior Citizens Act, 2007.

2. On 04.07.2022, notice of motion was issued by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court, subject to payment of Rs.25,000/- as litigation expenses to respondent No.2.

3. On 31.08.2022, Co-ordinate Bench of this Court was pleased to pass the following order: -

“As per office report, notices issued to respondent Nos.2 to 4 have not been received back either served or otherwise. Let fresh notices to respondent Nos.2 to 4 be issued again for 31.01.2023, on

furnishing of fresh process fee by the counsel for the petitioner, within a period of four weeks from today.
