AMARJOT BHATTI, J (Oral):

1. Learned counsel representing State pointed out that Sikander Singh Chauhan and Rajan Kumar Chauhan @ Gopi have filed petition for quashing of orders dated 05.05.2017 (Annexure P-4) and 16.01.2017 (Annexure P-5) passed by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Nakodar, District Jalandhar in case No.63/1/17 instituted on 28.07.2017 arising out of FIR No.167 dated 26.07.2016 under Sections 363, 366-A, 376 and 120-B IPC and Sections 4 and 6 of Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 (hereinafter referred to as POCSO Act) registered Police Station Shahkot, District Jalandhar (Annexure P-1). It is pointed out that as per the *parvi* report Sikander Singh Chauhan has been acquitted in this FIR on 01.02.2025 where as Rajan Kumar Chauhan @ Gopi is a proclaimed person.

Nobody is appearing on behalf of the petitioners since long. Last time, the learned counsel had appeared as per order dated 27.11.2017. Thereafter, the case was adjourned in routine due to heavy roster. Again



today, nobody has turned up on their behalf.

2. In the light of aforesaid factual position, it is apparent that nobody is interested to pursue the present petition, therefore, the same stands dismissed for want of non-prosecution.
