SANDEEP MOUDGIL, J.(ORAL)

1. The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondent No.2 to protect the lives and personal liberty of the petitioners and also directing respondents No.4 to 6 not to interfere in the personal lives and liberty of the petitioners.

2. Learned State counsel assures the Court that necessary action will be taken on the representation dated 10.04.2025 (Annexure P-5) after providing an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner(s), within a period of three days from today, in the light of notification No.HOMEHM-40 40SECM/14/2025-2H4/63 dated 23.01.2025 issued by the Department of Home Affairs, Punjab, Government of Punjab (Home-4 Branch).

3. In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, the present petition is disposed of in the aforesaid terms. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to seek revival of the instant petition in case, cause of action survives.
