SANDEEP MOUDGIL, J (ORAL)

This Criminal Writ Petition under Article 226 of the constitution of India has been filed praying for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 protect the life and liberty of petitioners, which is endangered at the hands of respondents No. 4 to 8 as the petitioners are living together against the wishes of the private respondents.

Learned State Counsel submits that statement of respondent No. 5-Gurpreet Kaur-mother of petitioner No.1 has been recorded whereas Shamsher Singh-respondent No.4-father of petitioner No.1 was not available for enquiry as he was away for some work in

Haryana and on that account, State Counsel seeks some time ensuring the Court that necessary orders will be passed after enquiry is complete.

A copy of order so passed be supplied to the petitioner within three days thereafter.

In light of the above assurance, counsel for the petitioner does not wish to press the instant petition at this stage and seeks withdrawal of the same.

Prayer is accepted.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

However, the petitioner would be at liberty to file appeal as is stipulated in the Standard Operating Procedure as per law, in the light of notification No.HOME-HM-40 40SECM/14/2025-2H4/63 dated 23.01.2025 issued by the Department of Home Affairs, Punjab, Government of Punjab (Home-4 Branch), in case of any grievance left after passing the speaking order.
