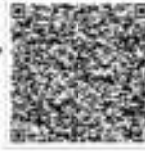

1. Feeling aggrieved against the alleged inaction on the part of respondent authorities, petitioners have approached this Court by way of instant petition, seeking issuance of appropriate directions to official respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and her family members from the private respondents.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have been running from pillar to post but their grievance was not being redressed by the respondent authorities despite of moving an application dated 03.04.2025 to SHO, Police Station City Barnala-respondent No. 3 (Annexure P2). Having been left with no other option, the petitioners have again approached the Senior Superintendent of Police, Barnala-respondent No.2 by way of representation dated 09.04.2025 (Annexure P-3), but the same is also pending decision. He also submits that the petitioners will be

satisfied in case respondent No.2 is directed to look into the matter and take appropriate steps, in accordance with law.

3. Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and after going through the case file, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Barnala-respondent No.2 to depute a senior police officer to look into the representation (Annexure P-3) and decide the same by passing an appropriate order thereon, strictly as per law, within a period of two weeks from today.
