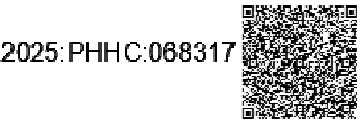
NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

1. This petition has been filed under Section 482 of the BNSS, 2023 seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.0077 dated 30.10.2023 registered under Section 366, 376, 120-B IPC at Police Station Bariwala, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

2. On 22.04.2025, the following order was passed by this Court:-

“The petitioner has filed the instant petition under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.77 dated 30.10.2023 registered under Sections 366, 376 & 120-B of IPC, 1860 at Police Station Bariwala, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

On receipt of advance copy of the petition, learned State counsel has put in appearance on behalf of respondent No.1-State and on instructions from ASI Rajbir



Singh, submits that the petitioner is also involved in another case i.e. FIR No.26 dated 02.04.2025 registered under Sections 118(1), 115(2), 191(3) & 190 of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 at Police Station Barnala, however, in the present petition, the said fact has not been disclosed.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks an adjournment to verify the abovesaid fact.

Adjourned to 06.05.2025.”

3. Thereafter, on 06.05.2025 on the request of learned counsel for the petitioner, case was adjourned for today. Today, there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner. It appears that petitioner is not interested in pursuing the present petition.

4. Dismissed for non-prosecution.
