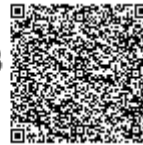

Prayer in the instant petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 4 to provide protection of life and liberty to the petitioners, at the hands of police officials of Police Station CIA Ludhiana, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has inter alia contended that the police officials of CIA Ludhiana are adamant to implicate petitioner No.2 or any of his two unmarried brothers namely, Jagjit Singh and Jawahar Singh residing with the petitioners in some false case, to get credit from the seniors on account of Drug Drive (Yudh Nashian Virudh). He has contended that the petitioner and his family members are being harassed and threatened by the police officials of CIA Ludhiana.

The perusal of the present petition reveals that, in the petition, there is no reference, that any complaint to the higher police officers was ever given by the petitioners regarding the same. Learned counsel for the petitioners has also conceded to aforesaid fact. Thus, the petitioners were

having efficacious alternative remedy available to them which has not been utilized.

In view of the above, the present petition is not maintainable and is disposed of accordingly.
