MANJARI NEHRU KAUL, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioners are seeking the concession of anticipatory bail, under Section 482 of BNSS, 2023, in FIR No.151, dated 13.03.2025, under Sections 190, 191(3), 115(2), 118(2), 238 of BNS, 2023, registered at Police Station Shahabad, District Kurukshetra.

2. On the last date of hearing i.e. 21.04.2025, while noticing the following submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioners, this Court had granted the concession of interim bail to the petitioners and asked them to join investigation:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioners, *inter alia*, contends that petitioners have not been attributed any injury on the person of the injured except that they held the complainant-injured by his arms while the co-accused inflicted injuries on the index finger of the complainant.”

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in compliance of order dated 21.04.2025, petitioners have joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency.

4. Learned State counsel, on instructions, does not dispute the factum of the petitioners having joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency. He, on further instructions, submits that the petitioners are not required for further investigation much less for their custodial interrogation.

5. In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 21.04.2025, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C./482(2) of BNSS, 2023.
