Prayer in the present petition is for directing the respondents to release the LTC budget of the petitioners for the Block Year 2020-2023 as per demand sent by respondent No.4 through communication No.2730 dated 18.12.2024.

After arguing at some length, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he would be satisfied at this juncture in case respondent No.2- Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, Haryana, Panchkula is directed to consider the present writ petition as a representation and to take a time bound decision thereupon.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Tanisha Peshawaria, DAG, Haryana accepts notice and submits that she has no objection to the request made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

Accordingly, in view of the above; with the consent of the parties and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of while directing respondent No.2 to treat the present writ petition as a representation and to consider and decide the same by passing a reasoned and speaking order after affording an opportunity of hearing to the respective parties within a period of four months of the receipt of certified copy of this order.

Needless to mention that upon considering the case of the petitioners, if any amount towards LTC for the abovementioned block year is found due and payable to the petitioners, the same shall be disbursed in their favour within a further period of two months.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
