Status report in the form of an affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sampla, District Rohtak, has been filed. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof has been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who seeks time to go through the same and to address arguments.

2. By way of present petition filed under Section 482 of BNSS, 2023, petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR as under:

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance to the order dated 28.04.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner has already joined the investigation and as such prayed for confirming the interim bail granted vide order dated 28.04.2025.



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4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Joginder Singh, intimates the Court that the petitioner has joined investigation and is neither required for further investigation nor for any custodial interrogation.

5. During the course of hearing on 28.04.2025, following order was passed:

“2. It is, inter alia, contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner having no criminal antecedents has been falsely implicated in this case. He contends that the petitioner is simply running a commission agent firm and has no role whatsoever in the allegations levelled in the FIR nor is he in any manner instrumental in the shifting of the bags in the warehouse of the HAFED and hence seeks concession of anticipatory bail.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Praveen Bhadu, Asstt. A.G. Haryana, present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the State-respondent and prays for time to file the status report/reply in the matter.

5. Adjourned to 15.05.2025

6. Needful be done well before the date fixed with an advance copy to the counsel opposite.

7. In the meanwhile, the petitioner is hereby directed to join investigation within seven days from today and in the event of his arrest, he is ordered to be released on interim bail on his furnishing personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. He shall also abide by conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) of BNSS. ”

6. Keeping in view the above submissions made by learned State counsel and the fact that the petitioner had joined the investigation consequent to the order dated 28.04.2025 passed by this Court, interim bail

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granted vide order dated 28.04.2025 is hereby confirmed, subject to conditions as envisaged under Section 482 (2) of BNSS, 2023. Further the petitioner is directed to join investigation as and when required in future by way of written notice for such purpose to be served by Investigating Officer of this case upon the petitioner; he will not tamper with the evidence nor will influence the witnesses and will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court.

7. The petition stands allowed.

8. It is made clear that anything contained hereinabove shall not be construed to be an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
