The present petition has been filed by the petitioners under Section 482 of of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS), 2023 for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 26, dated 14.03.2025, registered under Sections 115(2), 118(1), 305, 324(4), 351, 191(3), 190 of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 (for short-'BNS'), at Police Station Division 3, District Police Commissionerate Ludhiana.
2. Vide order dated 24.04.2025, passed by this Court, the petitioners were granted interim bail and were directed to join investigation.
3. Reply dated 19.05.2025 filed on behalf of the respondent-State is taken on record.
4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from the Investigating Officer, has submitted that that the petitioners have joined investigation on 27.04.2025 and they are not required for custodial interrogation.

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5. Keeping in view the above mentioned facts and circumstances, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 24.04.2025, granting interim bail to the petitioners, is made absolute, subject to compliance of usual terms and conditions requisite for grant of anticipatory bail.
