1. The petitioners through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India are seeking direction to respondents to allow them to continue in service.

2. The writ petition was admitted by this Court vide order dated 02.08.2004. It was ordered to be listed along with *CWP No.4114 of 2003*. Interim order was passed in same terms. By order dated 31.10.2003 passed in aforesaid petition, the respondents were directed not to relieve the petitioners. In view of interim orders, the petitioners might be working or may have retired.

3. A period of 21 years has already expired. There seems no reason to defer the matter, thus, it would be in the interest of justice, if interim order dated 02.08.2004 is made absolute. Accordingly, interim order dated 02.08.2004 is hereby made absolute.

4. Disposed of in above terms.



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5. The petitioners are at liberty to move an appropriate application within three months from today if cause survives.
