2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the application filed by the petitioner(s) were under Section 33-C (ii) where the adjudication could not have been done by the Labour Court hence, the present bunch of petitions may kindly be disposed of as having been not pressed any further with liberty to the petitioner(s) to avail an appropriate remedy to be adjudicated by an appropriate authority.

3. Ordered accordingly.

5. Pending application, if any, also stands disposed of.
