1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was working as Assistant Superintendent (Jail), Amritsar with the respondent-State and retired from service on 31.12.2009 but, in the service record of the petitioner, the name of the wife of the petitioner has not been correctly spelt. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that name of the wife of the petitioner is "Rashpal Kaur", whereas, the same has been spelt as "Rachanpal Kaur", hence, respondents be directed to correct the name of the wife of the petitioner so that, in case, at any point of time, the correct name of wife is needed for any benefit, the petitioner or his wife does not suffer any prejudice.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the said grievance has been raised by the petitioner in the legal notice dated 22.08.2024, copy of which has been appended as Annexure P-7 and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage, in case, the respondents are directed to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking prejudice.

4. Mr. T.P.S. Chawla, Senior DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that in case the legal notice (Annexure P-7) is received with the competent authority, the same will be looked into and an appropriate order will be passed within a period eight weeks from the date of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
