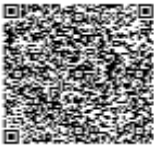

1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that order dated 03.04.2025 (Annexure P-8) has been passed by the District Development and Panchayat Officer, Taran Taran, directing the Panchayat to start the development work within a period of 15 days, so that, the funds, details of which have been given in the impugned order itself are utilized
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner does not have any objection to start the development work but, some of the Members are not cooperating. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that only intent of the department is to appoint an administrator to get the work executed though, the same is within the jurisdiction of the elected members of the Panchayat.
4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as of now, no order contrary to the interest of the Gram Panchayat has been passed by the



District Development Officer, hence, the petitioner intends to approach the District Development and Panchayat Officer, Taran Taran with the plea that the petitioner is ready to perform the duty for the development of the Gram Panchayat and will utilize the fund wherever required for by passing appropriate resolution but all the Panchayat Members should be directed to cooperate.

5. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents-State submits that in case, any such representation is received from the petitioner, appropriate decision will be taken by the District Development and Panchayat Officer, Taran Taran on the same by passing appropriate speaking order before implementing the letter dated 03.04.2025.

6. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the statement of the learned counsel for the respondent, the present petition may kindly be disposed of is not pressed any further.

7. Ordered accordingly.
