1. Present application has been filed under Section 151 CPC seeking permission to withdraw the main petition on the basis of compromise dated 18.10.2023 (Annexure P-6).

Learned counsel for the applicant-petitioner as well as counsel for respondent No.4 have jointly submitted that the present case in which, challenge is to the impugned orders dated 10.09.2021 (Annexure P-2) and 10.01.2022 (Annexure P-4) passed on the application of the petitioner under Section 23 of the Maintenance and Welfare of Parents and Senior Citizen Act 2007, has been compromised vide compromise deed dated 18.10.2023.

It is jointly prayed that the matter be preponed from 04.12.2023 to today

itself.
