By way of the present writ petition, the petitioners have sought issuance of an appropriate writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondent-authorities to de-seal the premises i.e. Back Courtyard of SCO No.12-A, Sector 7-C, Chandigarh. A further prayer has been made for quashing the order dated 21.07.2023 (Annexure P-4) passed by respondent No.2-Sub Divisional Magistrate (East), U.T., Chandigarh and the order dated 10.11.2023 (Annexure P-6) passed by respondent No.4-Chief Administrator, U.T., Secretariat.

2. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that the matter is already *sub judice* before the revisional authority and the petitioners can make necessary affidavit(s), as required before the revisional authority, which shall look into the same and pass an order. It has further been pointed out that the next date fixed before the revisional authority is 15.05.2025.

3. In view of the said fact, the petitioners are permitted to make necessary applications/affidavits before the revisional authority, which shall consider and pass an appropriate order thereon in accordance with law, preferably within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt/production of copy of this order.

5. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
