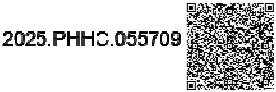

NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

1. Instant Criminal Writ Petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for directing respondents No.2 and 3 for protecting the life and liberty of the petitioner and not to interfere in his personal life.

2. Learned State counsel, on receipt of advance copy of the petition, and on instructions from ASI Rajesh Kumar (M. No.8872033422) submits that the representation dated 24.03.2025 (Annexure P-2) was received by the concerned SHO on 29.03.2025 and the same was marked to ASI Rajesh Kumar, who has tried to contact the petitioner at the address given in the representation, however, he was not found to be residing at the said address for the last 14 years and statement of the Sarpanch to this effect has also been recorded. He



further submits that if the petitioner approaches the Investigating Officer, the grievance of the petitioner raised in the representation dated 24.03.2025 (Annexure P-2) shall be redressed at the earliest.

3. In view of the statement of the learned State counsel, present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to approach the concerned Investigating Officer.
