Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of direction for protecting the life and liberty of the petitioner from the hand of respondents No.6 to 9.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that dispute is between the petitioner and respondent No.5 to 9 and the private respondents have filed a complaint against the petitioner. He submits that thus, the petitioner is being called by the police. He submits that the petitioner has filed a representation/application before the SHO concerned and the same is not taken into consideration. He submits that the petitioner is ready to appear before the SHO- respondent No.4.

Notice of motion to the official respondents only.

Mr. Tarun Aggarwal, Sr. DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4 i.e. SHO Police Station Mullepur, District Fatehgarh Sahib to take into consideration the complaint/application filed by the petitioner in accordance with law within a period of one month from today and grant immediate protection, if any threat to the life and liberty of the petitioner, is perceived. It is being clarified that this order shall not be taken to grant immunity to the petitioner for legal action for violation of law, if any, committed by him.
