SUDEEPTI SHARMA J. (Oral)

1. The present contempt petition has been filed for deliberate and intentional disobedience of order dated 05.02.2025 passed by this Court in CWP-3173-2025.
2. The relevant portion of order dated 05.02.2025 passed by this Court in CWP-3173-2025, is reproduced as under:-

“2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners would be satisfied, in case a direction is passed upon respondent no.4-Sub Registrar, Mahendergarh, to take a final decision on legal notice (Annexure P-1).

3. Considering the aforesaid prayer as made by learned counsel for the petitioners being innocuous and bona fide, this Court, without observing anything on the merits of the instant case, directs respondent no.4-Sub



Registrar, Mahendergarh, to take a final decision on the legal notice (Annexure P-1), by passing a speaking order, within a period of one month from today.”

3. Learned State counsel submits that in compliance of order dated 05.02.2025, a speaking order dated 26.08.2025 has been passed. Copy of the same has been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner and also placed on record.
4. A perusal of speaking order dated 26.08.2025, shows that order dated 05.02.2025 passed by the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court in CWP-3173-2025, has been complied with. Learned counsel for the petitioner does not dispute the same.
5. In view of the above, the contempt is purged and rule is discharged.
6. Pending application(s), if any, also stand disposed of.
