1. The petitioners assail the correctness of the concurrent orders passed by the courts below while directing the petitioner no.1 to pay interim maintenance pendente lite @ Rs.4,000/- per month. Originally the respondent filed petition under Section 12 of the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005, in which an application was filed for grant of interim maintenance. The court allowed the same.

2. The learned counsel representing the petitioners contends that from the photographs attached with the revision petition, it is evident that the respondent is residing happily with somebody else. He submits that in a complaint under Section 498 IPC, the petitioner has been acquitted.

3. Per contra, the learned counsel representing the respondent submits that the appeal against the acquittal under Section 498 IPC is



pending and the photographs are not admitted.

- 4. This court has considered the submissions of the learned counsel representing the parties.
- 5. The photographs produced by the petitioners are yet to be proved. Only an interim maintenance of Rs.4000/- per month has been granted to the respondent.
- 6. Keeping in view the aforesaid facts and discussion, no ground to interfere is made out.
- 7. Dismissed.
- 8. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
