1. The present petition has been filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (for short-‘BNSS’) for quashing of FIR No.53, dated 02.07.2024 under Sections 115(2) and 118(1) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 (For short “BNS”) (Section 238 of the Act added later on), registered at Police Station Sadar Moga, District Moga and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 01.04.2025 (Annexure P-2).

2. This Court vide order dated 20.05.2025 had directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa/Duty Magistrate to get their statements recorded and the learned Magistrate was directed to send its report qua the genuineness of the compromise.



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3. Pursuant to the aforesaid order, parties have appeared before the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Moga and got their statements recorded. On the basis of the statements so recorded, learned Magistrate has submitted report dated 10.06.2025 to the effect that the compromise has been effected between the parties voluntarily and without any coercion or undue influence.

4. Learned State counsel as well as counsel for respondent No.2 have not disputed the factum of compromise between the parties.

5. In view of the above, no useful purpose would be served to continue with the proceedings before the trial Court in the instant FIR.

6. Following the principles laid down by the Full Bench judgment of this Court in *Kulwinder Singh and others Versus State of Punjab and another 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052* and approved by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in *Gian Singh Versus State of Punjab and others (2012) 10 SCC 303*, this petition is allowed and FIR No.53, dated 02.07.2024 under Sections 115(2) and 118(1) of BNS, 2023 (Section 238 of the Act added later on), registered at Police Station Sadar Moga, District Moga and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 01.04.2025 (Annexure P-2) are quashed qua the petitioners.
