Through the instant petition filed under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (For short "BNSS"), the petitioners seek anticipatory bail in case FIR No.35 dated 03.03.2025 under Sections 333, 115(2), 126(2), 351(2), 191(3) and 190 of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, registered at Police Station Haibowal, District Ludhiana.

2. Vide order dated 30.04.2025, passed by this Court, the petitioners were released on interim bail and were directed to join investigation.

3. Learned State counsel has submitted that the petitioners have joined investigation on 20.05.2025 and they are not required for custodial interrogation.

4. Keeping in view the above facts and circumstances, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 30.04.2025, granting interim bail to the petitioners, is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 482(2) of the BNSS.
