Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (for short 'BNSS') for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in FIR No.49 dated 04.04.2025 (P-1), under Sections 126(2), 115(2), 109, 191(3), 351(2) read with Section 190 of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 (for short 'BNS') and Sections 25 and 27 of Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Dirba, District Sangrur.
