The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 528 of B.N.S.S with a prayer to set aside the impugned order dated 14.01.2025 (Annexure P-4) passed by the Judge, Special Court, Kapurthala (Annexure P-4), whereby the bail granted to the petitioner was ordered be cancelled and the bail bonds/surety bonds were forfeited to the State.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the the petitioner is ready to surrender before the Trial Court and some directions may be issued to the Trial Court to dispose of the bail application in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. I.P.S Sabharwal, DAG, Punjab, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent.

5. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the record

carefully.

6. I find the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner to be fair and genuine.

7. The petitioner may surrender before the Trial Court on or before 30.04.2025 and in case, any bail application is moved by the petitioner, the same shall be disposed of by the concerned Court expeditiously, in accordance with law.
